Dear Madrona Families and Staff,

As summer draws to a close, we wanted to provide you with updates concerning Madrona K-8 and the 2018-2019 school year.

Over the past several weeks, Edmonds School District has been working directly with the Washington State Department of Ecology (DOE) and the Washington State Department of Health (DOH) to develop a final monitoring plan for Madrona's stormwater wells. This monitoring plan was delivered to Olympic View Water & Sewer District (OVWSD) today, August 24, as part of a new proposal for a water service agreement. We hope to hear a favorable response from OVWSD before our mediation date of August 29, 2018, but wanted to share details with you right away.

The monitoring plan consists of three types of monitoring: groundwater level and gradient monitoring, groundwater quality monitoring, and stormwater quality monitoring. The monitoring plan sent to OVWSD includes an updated list of analytes (substances to be identified and measured), based on recommendations from DOE and DOH. It also includes a quality assurance plan.

Meanwhile, construction has been continuing at Madrona. In building A/B (administration, gym, and commons) the ceilings will be complete next week. The gym wall coverings have started with the gym floor scheduled for the middle of September. Buildings C and D (classroom wings) are complete except for walk coverings and window shades. Outside, irrigation work will start next week. We are on track for an overall construction completion date of October 16, 2018.


Modifications to transform traditional classrooms at the Former Alderwood Middle School into spaces that work for Madrona's multi-age structure and meet the Deaf and Hard of Hearing program's specialized accessibility standards are complete. Furniture and curriculum materials have been moved in.

We know that temporarily moving to the Former Alderwood Middle School has created issues with transportation and child care, and our Transportation Services department has been working to accommodate the additional needs created by the move. We have been able to add additional stops to fulfill each of the requests for transportation to child care. We are also in


